Class Presentation Instructions¹

In the four weeks prior to the final week, students will make a formal 30-minute presentation of their research to the class to solicit suggestions, critiques, and solutions to potential problems that arose in their AFA work. You are to formally present for 15 minutes and then open it up to class discussion inspired by your presentation for the last 15 minutes. In other words, you should use this time to engage with your classmates to better understand the particular issue(s), problem(s), success(es), or challenge(s) that you identified in your firm.

Using a PowerPoint presentation is optional but might be helpful to communicate your ideas. If you are going to use PowerPoint, please bring your presentations on a memory stick or CD, saved so it can be played on my MacBook which is running Office 2004 (this means you should NOT bring a version saved in Microsoft Vista). If you want to be extra careful, bring an overhead slide version of your presentation just in case the technology isn't cooperating.

Presentations will be evaluated on their clarity, research, use of course material, and critical analysis. While this is still an intermediate step in your term research, you should by now have a bit more information on your firm hand than you did when you wrote your AFA. So tell us about it. You are beginning, in other words, to answer the research questions you came up with in your AFA, so tell us about your progress thus far.

In sum, in your class presentations, you will:

- 1) recap what you discovered in your AFA (highlights of your AFA),

2) lay out the research questions you came up with and tell us WHY you felt these were important by using examples from your firm and/or your research into the social economy,

3) discuss how you intend to begin to answer or further explore in your CRP the particular issue(s), problem(s), success(es), or challenge(s) that you identified in your research questions and AFA, and

4) present us with a research plan of action for your final CRP work.
